<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ It is recommended that ALL participants wear satisfactory safety equipment including helmets, wrist and elbow guards and knee pads. ➤ We recommend participants under 16 wear helmets. However helmets are compulsory in the After School session and Saturday/Sunday morning Beginners session and for private hire. ➤ All scooters and bikes must have bar ends and scooter pegs must be removed before entrance to the park. ➤ No folding scooters, V scooters, three wheeled plastic scooters or play equipment, stabilisers or geared bikes under any circumstances. ➤ Anyone who is visibly intoxicated or under the influence of drugs shall not be permitted to participate. ➤ Alcohol is not permitted on Rush Skatepark premises. ➤ Smoking is not permitted within Rush Skatepark ➤ Spectators must not enter the ramp area ➤ No food or drink to be taken into ramp area.

Terms and Conditions

You must agree to these terms and conditions. Please familiarise yourself with these before using Rush Skatepark as these apply to all people using the facilities.

1. In the absence of negligence or fraudulent misrepresentation committed by Rush Skatepark, their employees, officers, officials or agents, these Terms hereby exclude to the fullest extent permitted by law all responsibility and liability for the death, personal injury or illness of any person whilst present on the site.
2. Neither Rush Skatepark or its employees or agents shall be responsible for any loss, theft or damage to valuables or any personal property that belongs to any person whilst on Rush Skatepark premises.
3. Rush Skatepark reserves the right to refuse admission to any person on any grounds. Anyone who is visibly intoxicated or under the influence of drugs shall not be permitted to take part or on the premises.
4. Minimum standards of conduct apply including, but not limited to, controlling your speed, not behaving in a way that endangers or alarms others, using the equipment safely and respecting all signage.
5. Any abusive, dangerous, rude or anti-social behaviour will not be tolerated and may lead to the member/participant(s) being removed from the park and receiving a ban.
6. No throwing of objects, including helmets, skateboards etc in the skatepark or anywhere in the building.
7. Rush Skatepark reserves the right to require you to leave the premises if you are deemed by a Rush Skatepark employee or officer not to be meeting reasonable standards of behaviour. In such cases, no refund will be given and a note placed on the members file.
8. No graffiti will be tolerated anywhere in the park.
9. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
- 10. We recommend participants under 16 wear helmets at all times. However, helmets are compulsory in the U16/After School Session and Saturday/Sunday Beginners sessions.**
11. Helmets are compulsory on the jump track, resi and foam pit.
12. We do not allow scooter pegs (exception to the rule for competitions) All bikes and scooters must have bar ends.
13. Buggies/pushchairs must not be taken into the park area under any circumstances.
14. In the interest of safety, beginners and those new to ramp riding should take time to familiarise themselves with the etiquette of the park before venturing into the main skating area.
- 15. No folding scooters, three wheeled plastic scooters, no stabilisers and no geared bikes under any circumstances.**
16. We do not advise beginners and young children ride this park at peak times. Please see our website for information on coaching or contact a member of staff for advice.
17. Under 16s MUST have consent of a parent or guardian. No entry to the park if a consent form has not been completed. There are no exceptions to this rule.
18. If you observe a hazard or damage or are injured whilst using Rush Skatepark facilities you must bring this to the attention of an employee immediately. An accident report form must be completed and any injury to the participant should be notified and recorded therein, signed by the injured person or their representative and witness statements taken.
19. By signing and agreeing to our terms and conditions, you are declaring you are fit to participate and have declared any existing injuries and/or medical conditions.
20. All participants will adhere to safety rules in place and understand the risks involved (serious injury/death). By participating you agree to accept responsibility for your own actions and involvement.
21. Due to the age of the building it is likely that there may be damp patches and condensation that appears on the ramps. We will do our utmost to make sure these are maintained to the best of our ability and every rider should be aware of this.
22. The use of recording equipment and photography in the Rush Skatepark is prohibited unless prior permission is gained or granted. Rush Skatepark will monitor and this footage and copyright is the property of Rush Skatepark solely. Users are advised this footage will be used for promotional and training purposes only.
23. School attendees should be aware that we will contact the appropriate authorities if we suspect anyone to be at the skatepark at a time we believe they should be in school.



- 24. Payment for use of Rush Skatepark will be made prior to participation. Anyone found to be in breach of this will be subject to having their membership removed.
- 25. No refunds will be made for "no show", late entry (other than that which has been caused by Rush Skatepark) or for leaving a session before the end. Exceptional circumstances may apply and will be at management discretion.
- 26. Any deception on the part of users of the skatepark will result in membership review or withdrawn, this may include multiple people using one membership, fraudulent entry to the park, forgery of documents etc.
- 27. Rush Skatepark reserves the right to change its policies and terms and conditions from time to time. Please read and observe these policies and terms and conditions displayed in reception of Rush Skatepark before you use the park in case changes have been made.
- 28. Rush Skatepark operates a no smoking policy.

MEMBERSHIP CARDS

- 1. A member will accumulate points (1p per £1.00) on paid entry or on any purchases within the café and Rush promotional goods only in the shop and after every ten sessions will be given one free two hour session. The ten sessions must be taken within one month.
- 2. If membership is renewed one month before the expiry date points accumulated over the year will be rolled over to the new membership.
- 3. All points must be redeemed within one year.
- 4. If a membership is revoked for any reason all points on your card will be invalid.

DISCLAIMER

The risk of injury from the activities involved in Rush Skatepark is significant, including the potential for permanent disability and death, and while particular rules, equipment and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious injury does exist. All participants knowingly and freely assume such risks, both known and unknown, and assume full responsibility for their participation and for having and using the appropriate safety equipment. We do not accept any responsibility for other participant's failure to comply with these rules other than due to our negligence.

DRUGS AND ALCOHOL DECLARATION

Rush Skatepark operates a zero tolerance Drugs & Alcohol Policy. Any person whether a participant or a spectator is found to be taking or dealing drugs or consuming alcohol will receive a life ban and possible further action. Anyone deemed intoxicated will not be allowed to enter the park.
